

# Stages of Climate School 180 Engagement

## 1. School Application

Open to all UK state schools (Primary and Secondary). Complete an online application form via the Learning through Landscapes (LtL) website. 180 schools, over 4 rounds until Spring 2026.

## 2. Shortlisting

Initial selection, followed by a short interview with headteacher before confirmation of school participation.

## 3. School Confirmation

Successful schools will be notified and asked to indicate their preferred delivery date options and provide participating staff details ('the influencers').

## 4. Delivery Booking

LtL trainer will liaise with school directly to confirm delivery date and plan for the climate grounds audit and in-person workshop.

## 5. Online Training

Participating staff will complete 3 online learning modules (about 3 hours total) and contribute to online discussions *prior* to school visit by LtL trainer.

## 6. Audit & Workshop

LtL trainer visits school for the day to conduct a climate grounds audit with a member of staff and a few pupils (1-2hrs), followed by the CS180 workshop for participating staff (3-4hrs)

## 7. Delivery Follow-Up

LtL trainer will send school an audit summary, an example CS180 Pledges form, and links to resources and online discussion forum.

## 8. School Commitment

School develops CS180 pledges to embed climate change curriculum and implement school ground changes. LtL trainer will organise a progress follow-up online meeting.

## 9. Progress Follow-Up

Follow-up online meeting with LtL trainer 2-3months later (approx. 30 min).
